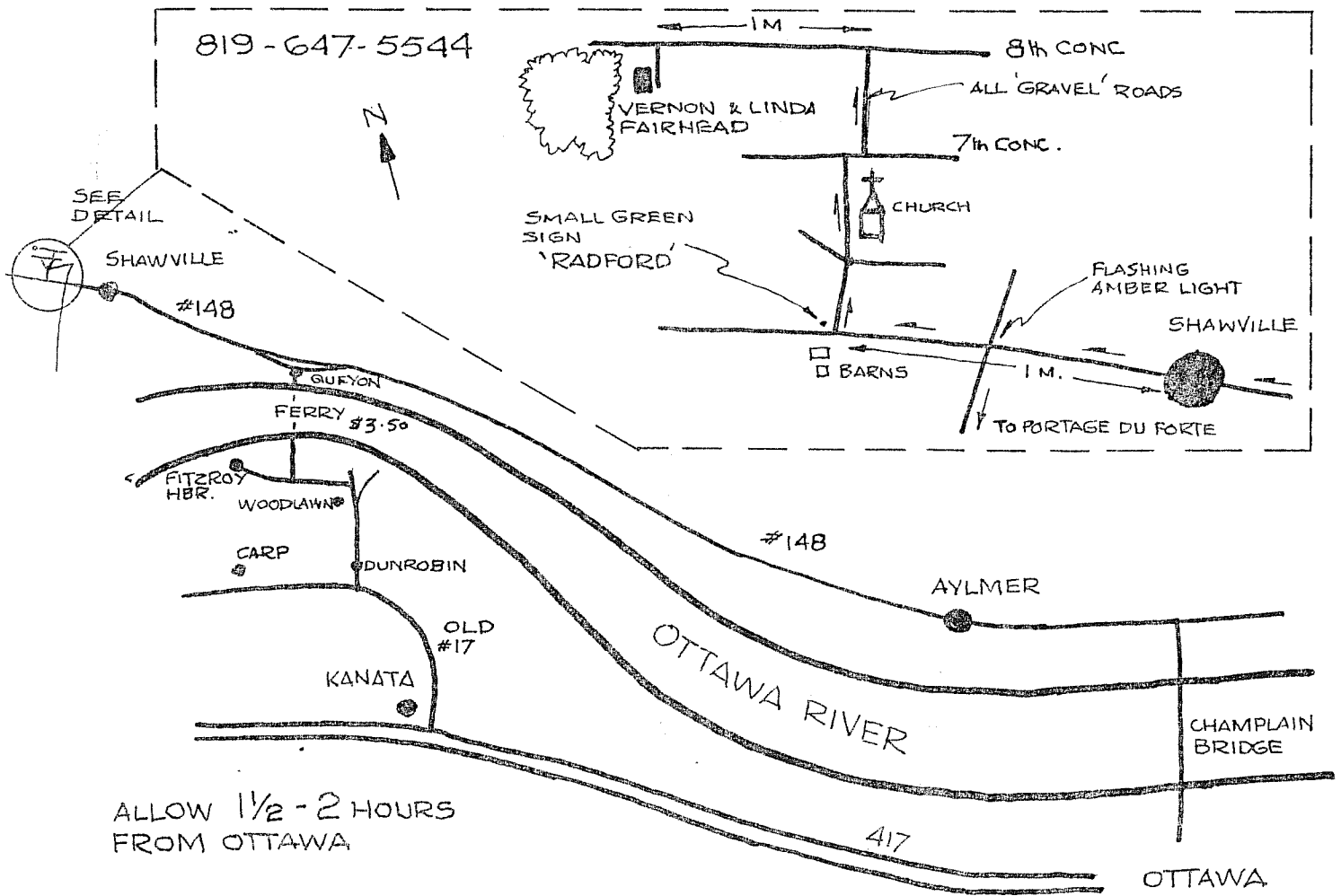
The club wishes to welcome two new members, John Lewis of Addison and Tom Mayor of Ottawa, hope to see you at the pic-nic.
